# Boys Lower Peninsula Cross Country

## White Lake Lakeland Triumphs In 'A' Race

The MHSAA Lower Peninsula Cross Country meets were held for the first time Saturday at Michigan International Speedway, and Milford Lakeland won its first boys Class A title since 1991.

Milford Lakeland finished with 94 points, followed by Traverse City (99) and Ann Arbor Huron (225). Lakeland's victory ended a string of three straight runner-up finishes.

Milford Lakeland won despite losing its top runner, Nick Gow, who suffered a foot injury a mile into the race.

Lance Binoiemi was fifth in 15 minutes, 52 seconds. Rich Oltesvig finished 20th, Mike Camilleri 21st and Ryan Johns 22nd.

Hazel Park exchange student Gus Forget finished in 15:40 to win the individual title. Forget, from Belgium, took the lead in the final 1,000 meters and sprinted to victory.
