THE RATINGS::: This is the thirdd set of CCIR RANKINGS for the 2016 Season. We are now starting to enter the interesting part of the season. Most teams have had 3 or more invitationals so we are getting a better look at more teams. This week $\&^{*}$ next are the last 2 real weeks of invitational as teams will begin to finish out their conference schedule \& prepare for regionals the following two weeks.
This week will see the Portage Invitaitonal and the Oakland County Meet. The following week will see the Greater Lansing, Ann Arbor Richard, Macomb County along with numerous area invitaitonals. The week before regionals will see a limited number of invitationals and a significant number of conference chapmionships.
This is the interesting part of season because there are not a significant number of "rematches" of ranked teams with a lot of reversals of the original results. Who is the better team..... the one that beat the other first or the one that just won. There will be many "rematches" in the coming conference \& regional meets \& then the "final rematch" at the MHSAA Finals.

Saline Girls ran "B" team at Coaching Legends only about 3 runners that ran at Jackson. Seaholm Grils beat Northville Girls at Coaching Legends as Sehaolm moved from \#3 in D1 to \#1. Dearborn Divine Child Girls missing $1 \& 2$ at Marauder Invitaitonal Saturday.
Rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results my Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name \& email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening. We are late in the evening this week.
There was a communication problem on my part and I did not get the panel completely in place for the vote this week. Hopefully things will be taken care of for next week. We would still like to add a couple more to the panel. Please contact me if you are interested please contact me.
