THE RATINGS::: This is the fourth set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2016 Season. We are now starting to enter the interesting part of the season. Most teams have had 3 or more invitationals so we are getting a better look at more teams. Thee are getting to be more invitationals with teams from D3 & D4 alone & not buried in a field with D1 & D2 teams. The panel and invitational are starting to solidify on the top teams but there is not much difference between teams in the "others" section especially in the smaller divisions.

Mllford/boys is starting their annual push with thjeir showing at Oakland County. Theyran White who has not shown up in previous results. Fremont/boys was missing Moon in some of their earlier meets but they had him at Portage. Pioneer/girls who won Portage had both Dawes running. One was missing at MSU Elite. Lansing Catholic beat St. Francis by only 1 point at Portage.

This week is probably the last real week of invitationals as next week is mostly conference meets and some local regional meets and many teams taking the week off from competition. This week will see Greater Lansing, AA Richard, Macomb County, News Herald along with the usual mix of local meets.

This is the interesting part of season because there are a significant number of "rematches" of ranked teams with a lot of reversals of the original results. Who is the better team..... the one that beat the other first or the one that just won. There will be many "rematches" in the coming conference & regional meets & then the "final rematch" at the MHSAA Finals.

We listed some conference jamborees in this issue & hope to have more next issue. This issue is being emailed Tues. evening. It will probably go back to Wed. next week as we are hosting our conference's final jamboree next Tues.

Rankings are based on invitational results only! Ask meet managers to get us the results. We need to have results my Monday in order to make that week's issue. We have had good support from meet managers getting us the results. If you do not see a meet listed here please send us the results.

Teams are awarded points according to how they finish in the invitationals they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitationals are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of eight, with only one being counted each week. If a school has more that the maximum number for that week of the season, they will only receive the invitational points for the maximum allowed for that week. Total number of invitational wins will be indicated in the parenthesis. Coaches vote each week.

We distribute the rankings each week. If your local paper would like to receive them, send us a name & email and we will include them on our list. The rankings are distributed each Tuesday evening. We are late in the evening this week.
